Behaviour Policy and Procedure

"The welfare of all our children is paramount"

1. All the children are treated as individuals.
2. The rights of all the staff and children should be respected.
3. Children will be actively involved in all discussions and actions regarding their behaviour.
4. Children are encouraged to take responsibility for their own behaviour and its consequences.
5. No swearing or unkind remarks will be tolerated.
6. Children must take care of all toys and equipment and be responsible for tidying them away.
7. Staff should reinforce what is meant by good behaviour in all activities, by speaking in a positive tone.
8. Breakfast is to be consumed seated at a table before engaging in any other activity.
9. The rules and policies of the Breakfast Club and school must be adhered at all times.

If a child displays continuous unacceptable behaviour the following procedures will be implemented: -

1. Verbal warning to parent/carer.
2. Written warning to parent/carer.
3. Suspend the child for one half term.
4. Reintroduce the child back into breakfast club on a gradual basis, reinforcing the behaviour that is expected.
5. Persistent bad behaviour after these measures have been taken may mean permanent exclusion from the breakfast club.

We as a school will be committed to working continually with parents/carers to ensure the child's well being.
