

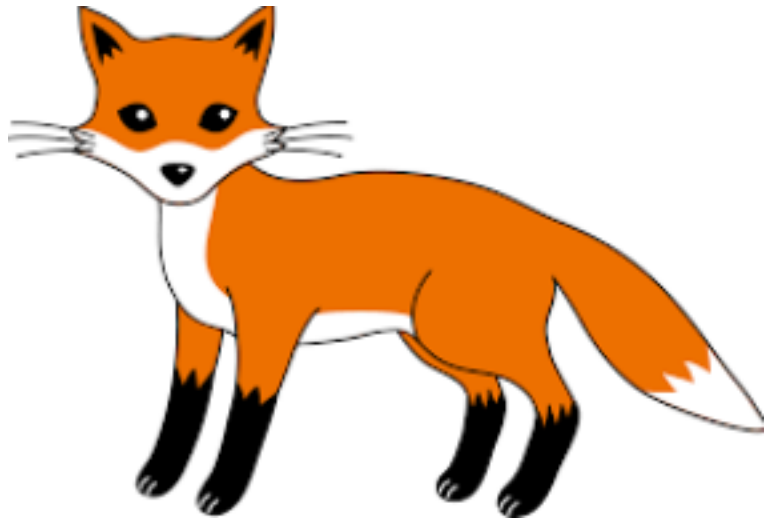
Fox
