

Who has ever had jet lag after a long flight somewhere abroad?


Time zones all relate to an agreed-on place: The prime meridian line (0° longitude) in Greenwich, London, UK.







Began in 1884

But wasn't fully official around the world until




This time zone is referred to as Coordinated Universal Time (UTC). Other time zones are usually increasing or decreasing increments of an hour from this location.
