Can I begin and open my short story?

Criteria	Me	Miss S
<b>Target:</b> Choose something you want to work on- perhaps something you needed to do in the last piece of work		
<b>Vocabulary:</b> <b>Good-</b> Use word mats for interesting adjectives and adverbs <b>Amazing-</b> Use simile and metaphor, as well as adjectives and adverbs <b>Awesome-</b> Use a range of figurative language- adjectives, adverbs, repetition, simile, metaphor, alliteration etc		
<b>Sentence Level:</b> <b>Good-</b> Use a subordinate conjunction to join two parts of a sentence (but, if, as) <b>Amazing-</b> Use a relative clause <b>Awesome-</b> use brackets or dashes to add parenthesis and extra information to a sentence.		
<b>Text Level:</b> <b>Good-</b> clear paragraphs to show a change in place, time, feeling, atmosphere. <b>Amazing-</b> A twist or surprise ending <b>Awesome-</b> Speech and dialogue integrated with narrative		

Your target will come from your last piece of work (next steps) OR something you want to work on.

Layout options and standards for written work

- Font no bigger than a size 18
- If you are using colour, just one colour
- One picture per page which is small (a quarter of the page or less)
