

Paper Plate Spider

You will need:

- One paper plate
- Black paint
- Googly eyes
- 8 black pipe cleaners
- Paint brush
- Hole Punch
- White glue (such as PVA)



Place the paper plate upside down, then paint it black, before leaving to dry.



Use a hole punch to make four holes on either side of the plate, around the rim.



Thread a pipe cleaner through one of the holes, then bend it into a zigzag shape to create a leg. Secure the pipe cleaner by twisting it around itself at the rim of the plate.



Repeat step 3 with the remaining seven pipe cleaners.



Using white glue (such as PVA), stick googly eyes on to the front of the paper plate.

Paper Plate Spider

You will need:

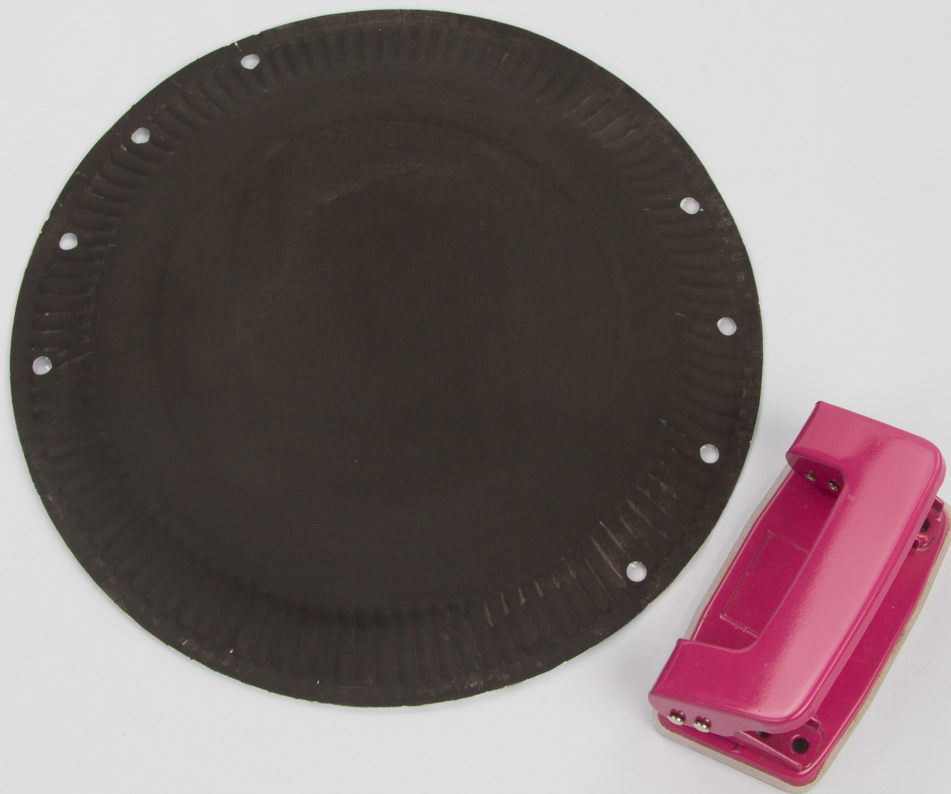
- One paper plate
- Black paint
- Googly eyes

Step 1

Place the paper plate upside down, then paint it black, before leaving to dry.



Step 2

Use a hole punch to make four holes on either side of the plate, around the rim.



Step 3

Thread a pipe cleaner through one of the holes, then bend it into a zigzag shape to create a leg. Secure the pipe cleaner by twisting it around itself at the rim of the plate.



Step 4

Repeat step 3 with the remaining seven pipe cleaners.



Step 5

Using white glue (such as PVA), stick googly eyes on to the front of the paper plate.
