# Paper Fan

## Supplies

- A4 coloured paper or thin card
- Glitter
- PVA glue
- Paintbrush
- Stickers of jewels
- Ribbon
- Sticky tape



- 2 large lolly sticks (optional)



- 1 First, take the paper or card and lay it out landscape. Now begin to decorate one half of the paper, going along the length. We have used a little glue to stick on some yellow ribbon and some red jewels.



- 2 Continue to decorate the fan by drizzling some PVA glue on it and sprinkling glitter on top. Leave to dry.



- 3 Now you are ready to fold your fan! To do this, fold one of the shorter ends of the piece of paper over and then turn over. Fold the paper backwards to create another fold and then turn over again. Repeat this process for the length of the paper to create a zigzag or concertina shape.



- 4 Finally, press both ends of the bottom of the concertina together and wrap some sticky tape around to seal them together. You should be left with a lovely fan!



- 5 You may want to use some glue to carefully stick a pair of lolly sticks to the handle of your fan, in order to give it more support.

# Paper Fan



## Supplies

- A4 coloured paper or thin card

Fold the paper backwards to create another fold and then turn over again. Repeat this process for the length of the paper to create a zigzag or concertina shape.



**Step 4.** Finally, press both ends of the bottom of the concertina together and wrap some sticky tape around to seal them together. You should be left with a lovely fan!
