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Handprint Dragon

Supplies

- Dragon head and tail templates
- Felt tip pens or coloured pencils
- Scissors
- Paper
- Paint
- Paintbrush



- Shallow trays or plates
- PVA glue



- 1 First, use either felt tip pens, coloured pencils or paint to colour the dragon head and tail templates.



- 5 Once your handprints are dry, carefully cut around them.



- 2 Next, carefully cut out the dragon head and tail.



- 6 Next, choose a handprint and use the glue to stick it onto the back of your dragon's head, with the fingers pointing towards the tail end.



- 3 Now you can start making the dragon's body using handprints! To do this, carefully press your hand into some paint, you may want to use the paintbrush to spread the paint all over your palm. Then gently press your hand onto a piece of paper.



- 7 Continue sticking the handprints together to make a long line of them for your dragon's body!



- 4 Repeat step 3 about 10 times to make a long dragon. You may want to use a few different colours!



- 8 When you have used all of your handprints, stick the dragon's tail onto the end. Allow to dry and then your dragon is finished!

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
