Beijing	The capital city of China.
Country	A area of land with its own government and name.
Continent	A group of countries.
Asia	The group of countries that China is in.
Europe	The group of countries that England is in.
Village	A small place where not many people live. There are some houses and few shops.
Town	A medium place where thousands of people live. There are schools, shops, parks, transport but usually no airport.
City	A big place where millions of people live. Cities often have big buildings like skyscrapers, stadiums, cathedrals and airports.
Environment	The sky, land and water around us for example rivers, lakes or the sea.
Human features	The things people have built in the environment for example: roads; schools; shops; stadiums etc.
Physical features	Natural things in our environment (people did not put them there). For example hills, mudflats and rivers etc.
London	The capital city of England.
Shoreham- By-Sea	The town where our school is.
Coast	Land next to the sea.
Mud flats	Area of mud that is sometimes flooded by the river.
River Adur	The river that runs through Shoreham-By-Sea.
Shoreham Airport	A small airport, in Shoreham, where small planes and helicopters land and take off.
