<b>China</b>	China is a large country.
<b>Beijing</b>	The capital city of China.
<b>Country</b>	A area of land with its own government and name.
<b>Continent</b>	A group of countries.
<b>Asia</b>	The group of countries that China is in.
<b>Europe</b>	The group of countries that England is in.
<b>Village</b>	A small place where not many people live. There are some houses and few shops.
<b>Town</b>	A medium place where thousands of people live. There are schools, shops, parks, transport but usually no airport.
<b>City</b>	A big place where millions of people live. Cities often have big buildings like skyscrapers, stadiums, cathedrals and airports.
<b>Environment</b>	The sky, land and water around us for example rivers, lakes or the sea.
<b>Human features</b>	The things people have built in the environment for example: roads; schools; shops; stadiums etc.
<b>Physical features</b>	Natural things in our environment (people did not put them there). For example hills, mudflats and rivers etc.
<b>London</b>	The capital city of England.
<b>Shoreham-By-Sea</b>	The town where our school is.
<b>Coast</b>	Land next to the sea.
<b>Mud flats</b>	Area of mud that is sometimes flooded by the river.
<b>River Adur</b>	The river that runs through Shoreham-By-Sea.
<b>Shoreham Airport</b>	A small airport, in Shoreham, where small planes and helicopters land and take off.
