Questions to Extend and Deepen Understanding

While the children are completing the challenge, you may wish to ask them the following questions:

- What can you see on the pirate map?

- Where is the pirate ship?
- Can you tell me where the parrot is in a different way?
- Can you use the words next to/in front of/between to describe where the... is on the map?
- Can you find the pirate flag? Where is it?
- How could the pirate get to the treasure chest?
- Can you tell me another way the pirate could get to the treasure chest?
