What questions do you have about life in space?

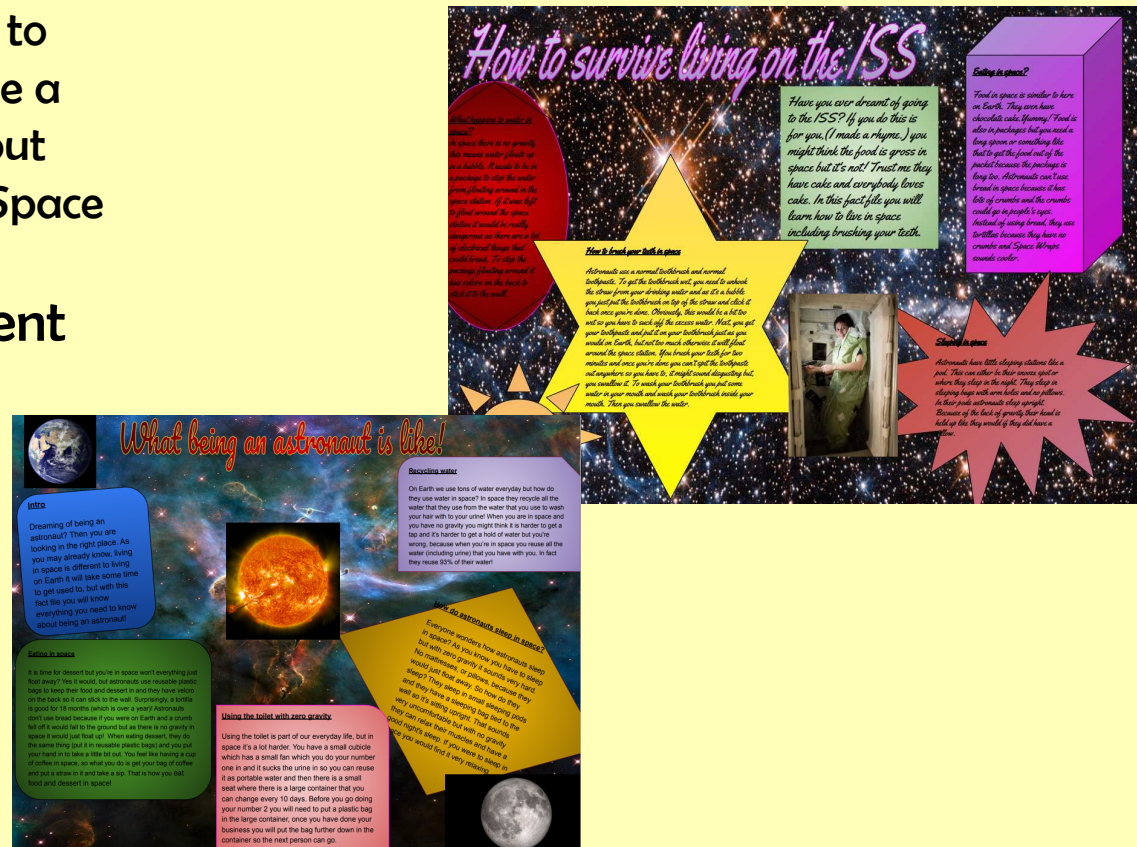
- Is it hard having to leave your friends and family?

Text Level:

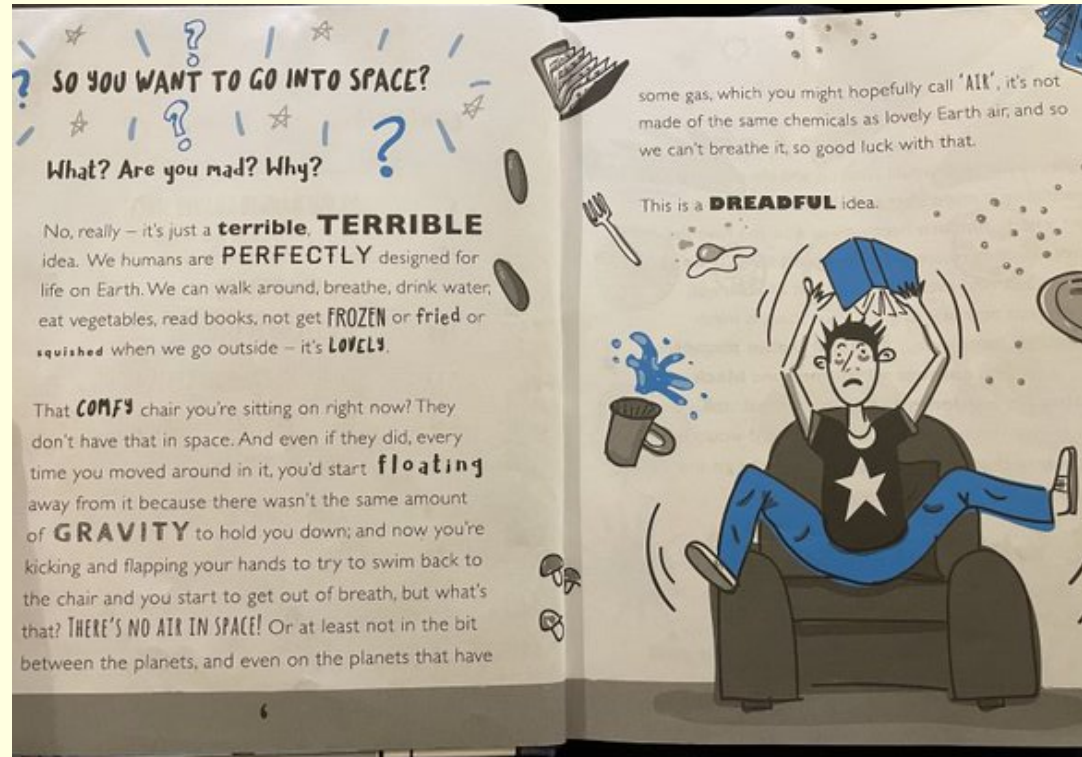
Good: Have an introduction and three paragraphs about an aspect of life in space

Awesome: Have an introduction and then five or more paragraphs about an aspect of life in space.

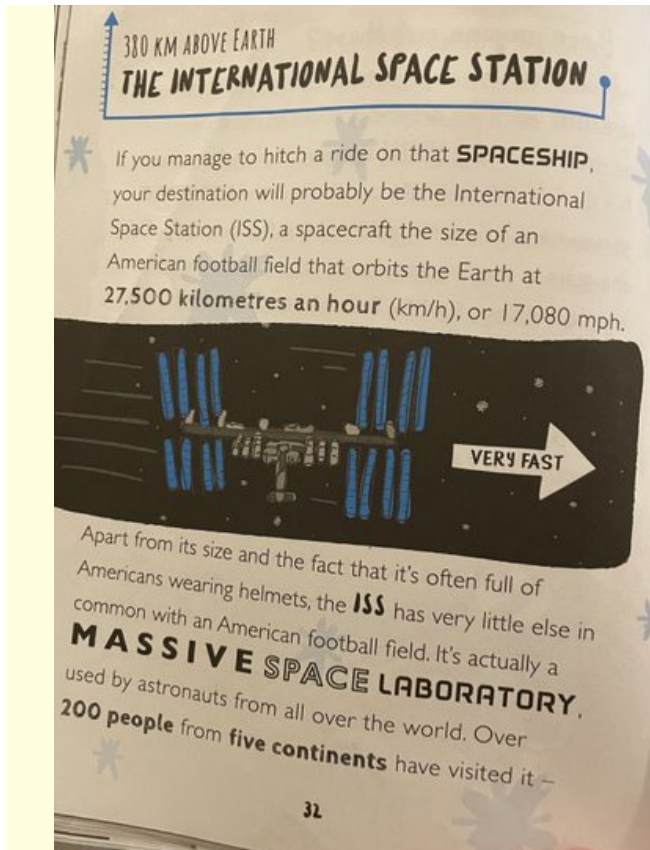
