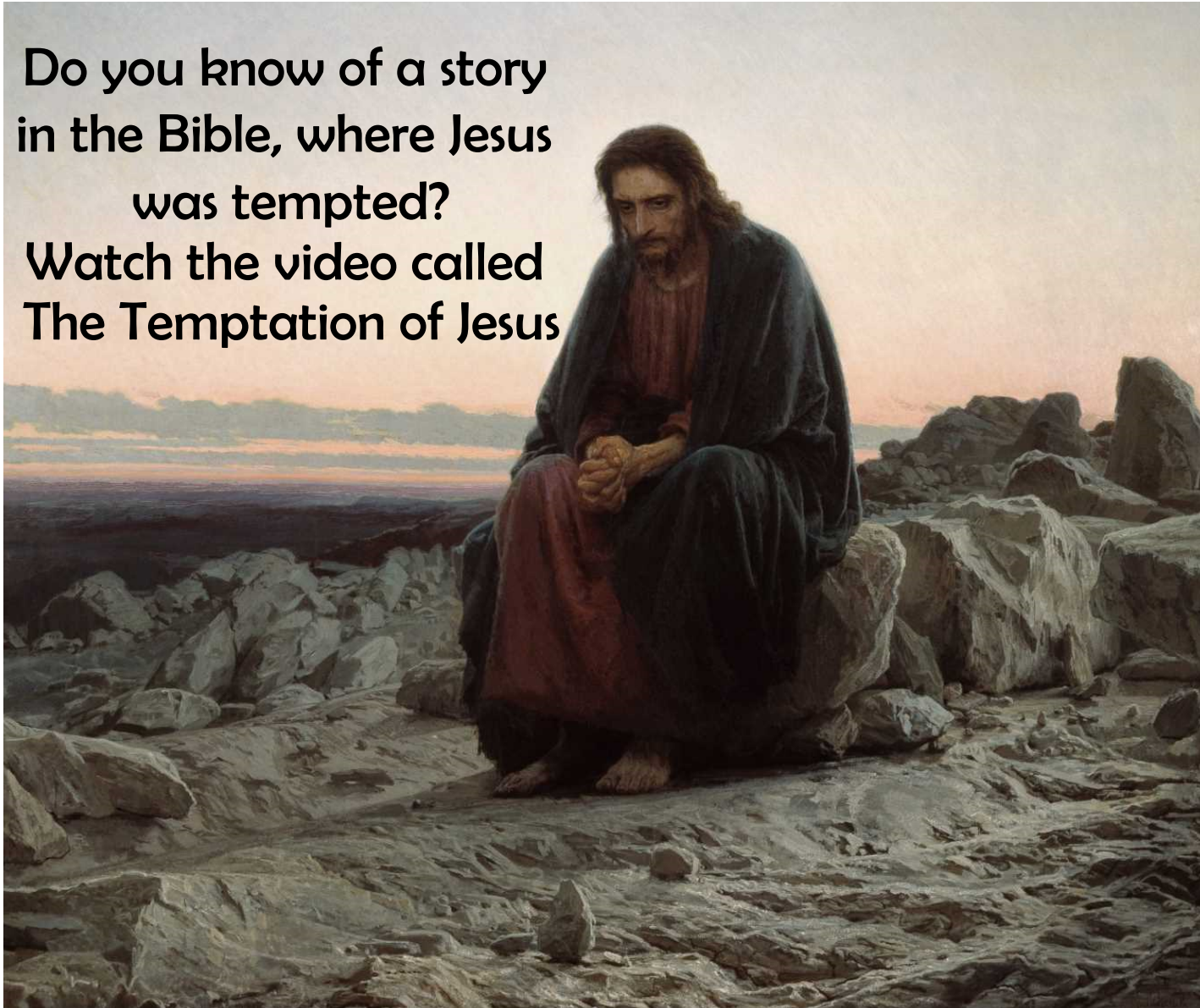

Helpful Facts:

- Lent is a time of getting ready
- Jesus went to the desert for 40 days and 40 nights, he did not eat or drink in this time.
- Lent marks the time leading to Jesus' sacrifice
- The Devil tried to tempt him but Jesus resisted, tempted with bread, power/money, recognition as the son of God.
- Lent starts on Shrove Tuesday
- It ends on Easter Sunday
- Christians may take up fasting, giving up foods they enjoy.
- Lent is 40 days long (not including the Sundays as these are joyful days for us)
- They may even try and do things for others at this time of year.
- Lenten Promises
- The colour used during Lent is purple, crosses are covered up in church
