This Week

This week, we have been getting ready for Harvest assemblies (see below). The children have been working hard in RE lessons too. We know that at St Peter's we aim to have love at the centre of all that we do but this term, we are going to also show that we care. The children have worked really hard to move around the school and present their work with care. We are very proud of them.

The children in Reception have been counting in many different ways. Counting Owl has been visiting quite a bit. They have also been writing Goldilocks stories. In Year one, the children have been learning about Neil Armstrong and have also been making rockets. The children in Year 2 celebrated "Pirate Day" which included sword fighting, firing cannons, climbing rigging and also dug up pirate treasure. Story writing was the focus for Year 3; they have been writing a recount of the story of the Tortoise and the Hare. The children in Year 4 wrote letters to explain why the River Nile was so important to the Ancient Egyptians. Year 5 managed to finish diary entries as well as separating mixtures in science. The children in Year 6 have been learning how to tackle multi-step problems.

Free School Meals (FSM) Eligibility Criteria ***IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ****

Free school meals in all West Sussex maintained and free schools and academies are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits –

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

If you <u>are not</u> eligible for benefits-related, free school meals, but your child is currently in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, they will automatically be entitled to Universal Infant Free school Meals and you need not apply.

If you <u>are</u> eligible for benefits-related free school meals in accordance with the above criteria, and your child is also receiving Universal Infant Free School Meals, it is important that you continue to register. This will enable us to claim valuable 'pupil premium' funding (currently £1,385 per child per annum). This additional funding can enable us to provide extra support for your child in school.

Once an eligible child is signed up for benefits related free school meals, they will also receive other support such as Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) sessions. HAF sessions provide children with access to fun and engaging activities during the holidays and offer a free meal as part of the sessions.

If you think your child(ren) may be eligible for benefits-related free school meals, please contact Mrs Matthews in the school office.




