Easyfundraising

In case you weren't aware, the followinging supermarkets – Tesco, Morrisons, ASDA, Waitrose, Sainsbury's, Iceland and Ocado partner with Easyfundraising. You will need to be registered with Easyfundraising and have selected St Peter's school as your chosen charity. When you shop online for your weekly food shop with one of these retailers, the supermarket then sends us a free donation as a thank you. In most cases, supermarkets offer a flat monetary amount of up to £5.50 and others offer a percentage based on what the online shopper spends. Tax Free Childcare for Parents and Carers

Tax-Free Childcare (TFC) is a childcare top-up for working parents. It can be used to help pay for accredited holiday clubs, childminders or sports activities. We are registered for the scheme and accept Tax Free Childcare vouchers for payment at our Sunrise Breakfast Club. TFC enables parents and carers to access childcare during the school holidays. It is estimated that there are 1.3 million working families who are eligible for TFC in the UK, however only a small percentage are making use of the scheme. Around 75% of families are losing out on this support. TFC is available for children aged up to 11, or 17 if the child has a disability. Many parents don't realise that TFC can be saved up on their accounts. Even if childcare is not required throughout the school terms, there is still the option to save up funds which could be used for holiday clubs or out of school care. Free School Meals (FSM) Eligibility Criteria ***IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ****

Free school meals in all West Sussex maintained and free schools and academies are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits –

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

If you <u>are not</u> eligible for benefits-related, free school meals, but your child is currently in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, they will automatically be entitled to Universal Infant Free school Meals and you need not apply.

If you <u>are</u> eligible for benefits-related free school meals in accordance with the above criteria, and your child is also receiving Universal Infant Free School Meals, it is important that you continue to register. This will enable us to claim valuable 'pupil premium' funding (currently £1,385 per child per annum). This additional funding can enable us to provide extra support for your child in school.

Once an eligible child is signed up for benefits related free school meals, they will also receive other support such as Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) sessions. HAF sessions provide children with access to fun and engaging activities during the holidays and offer a free meal as part of the sessions.

If you think your child(ren) may be eligible for benefits-related free school meals, please contact Mrs Matthews in the school office.
