It has been lovely to have the children back at school for the last two weeks after the Easter holidays. They have been enjoying being able to play on the school field again and it has been good to watch them playing and having fun in the extra space. This week Reception have been thinking about the story of the Ascension and have created pictures of what heaven looks like. The caterpillars have arrived and have already started to grow! Year 1 have written their own Samuel Pepys diaries to retell the Great Fire of London, talking about what they could see, hear, feel and smell. In maths they have been measuring length and height with cubes and learned how to use rulers to measure in whole centimetres. Year 2 have been creating their own twisted tales based on the story of The Three Little Pigs. Year 3 have been writing negative hotel reviews and trying to make the hotel sound horrible! Year 4 have been mapping the human and natural features of Shoreham as a grip map and also writing a tourist brochure for Shoreham. Year 5 have been writing Greek maths, learning about the human life cycle and producing line graphs. They have also produced a very interesting time line of all the children's birthdays. Year 6 had a visit from PCSO Chris and have been writing letters asking about wearing their leavers hoodies in school! After visiting Year 6 PCSO Chris then led a whole school assembly for the children about being safe.

Free School Meals (FSM) Eligibility Criteria ***IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ****

Free school meals in all West Sussex maintained and free schools and academies are available to pupils in receipt of, or whose parents are in receipt of, one or more of the following benefits –

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

If you <u>are not</u> eligible for benefits-related, free school meals, but your child is currently in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, they will automatically be entitled to Universal Infant Free school Meals and you need not apply.

If you <u>are</u> eligible for benefits-related free school meals in accordance with the above criteria, and your child is also receiving Universal Infant Free School Meals, it is important that you continue to register. This will enable us to claim valuable 'pupil premium' funding (currently £1,385 per child per annum). This additional funding can enable us to provide extra support for your child in school.

Once an eligible child is signed up for benefits related free school meals, they will also receive other support such as Holiday Activity and Food (HAF) sessions. HAF sessions provide children with access to fun and engaging activities during the holidays and offer a free meal as part of the sessions.

If you think your child(ren) may be eligible for benefits-related free school meals, please contact Mrs Matthews in the school office.


